**MINUTES**  
**Board Meeting**  
**Wednesday, April 13, 2011**

The Board of Dental Examiners of Alabama met Wednesday, April 13, 2011, at Warren & Company, Inc., 610 S. McDonough Street, Montgomery, Alabama for a special meeting.

The President called this special meeting to order at 2:30 p.m. with the following members in attendance: Dr. Thomas T. Willis, Jr., President, Dr. David Northcutt, III, Secretary/Treasurer, Dr. Hunter Pope, and Ms. Sandra Kay Alexander. Also in attendance were Mr. Keith E. Warren, Executive Director, Dr. Donna L. Dixon, General Counsel, and Mr. Billington Garrett, Office of the Attorney General. A quorum was present to conduct business.

The Board discussed HB 451 which was in the Children and Senior Advocacy Committee earlier that morning. There were several options discussed regarding negotiations of this legislation and directed Mr. Warren to work with Mr. Windom and other individuals involved in this legislation to develop some type of agreed upon language that would benefits both entities.

At 2:35 p.m. Dr. Pope made a motion to retire to executive session and return to public session at approximately 2:45 p.m. Ms. Alexander seconded the motion, Counsel approved, and the President called for the vote: Ms. Alexander, yea, Dr. Northcutt, yea, Dr. Pope, yea, and Dr. Willis, yea. The motion carried 4-0.

At 2:42 p.m. Dr. Northcutt made a motion to retire from executive session. Dr. Pope seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously approved by the Board.

Dr. Northcutt made a motion regarding Case # 2011-05, that a notice of hearing be issued for June 6, 2011 to include 2 Counts of Gross Negligence pertaining to drug log not being accurately maintained and practicing while impaired. A consent order to include a fine of \$3,000 is to be enclosed with the Notice of Hearing for consideration. The motion was seconded by Dr. Pope and approved by general consent.
